THENCE, continuing Easterly, a distance of 100 feet to the Southwest Corner (SW/COR) of a tract recorded at Book 1084 Page 19, THENCE, Northerly along the West line of said tract recorded at Book 1084 Page 19, a distance of 200.00 feet to the Northwest Corner (NW/COR) of said tract recorded at Book 1084 Page 19; THENCE, North 89 degrees 59 minutes 47 seconds West, a distance of 100 feet to a point on the East line of tract of land recorded at Book 996 Page 989; THENCE, Southerly along the East line of said tract of land recorded at Book 966 Page 989, a distance of 200 feet to the Southeast Corner (SE/COR) of said tract of land recorded at Cook 966 Page 989 and POINT OF BEGINNING, as a public street.
