CURBSIDE ITEMS MUST BE OUT BY 6:00AM TO GUARANTEE PICKUP

PLEASE BAG, BOX, OR BUNDLE ALL CURBSIDE ITEMS.

ABSOLUTELY NO LARGE PILES OF CONSTRUCTION OR DEMOLITION DEBRIS.

The following items will be picked up curbside:

- Brush- no more than 4' in length and 2" in diameter, no more than 50 lbs
- Furniture that can be easily crushed
- Mattresses *up to* full size
- Guttering less than 4' in length

The following items must be taken to the dumpsters at Knipe & Industrial:

- Large amounts of brush
- Metal or wood *longer* than 4' in length
- Railroad ties
- Scrap Metal
- Tires (must be removed from the rim, no large tractor tires)
- Vehicle batteries
- Mattresses *larger than* full size
- Heavy furniture, including sofa beds

**The following items must be taken to the Iowa Tribe Community Recycling Center
Located at 1051 W. Freeman:**

- Televisions
- Appliances
 - *Freezers, refrigerators, and AC units must have Freon removed and be tagged prior to disposal. Country Comfort will provide this service free of charge from April 7-April 11.*
- Computers, monitors, and other electronics
- Ink & toner cartridges
- Rechargeable batteries
- Recyclable plastic, paper, & cardboard products
- Aluminum, steel, & tin cans
- Petroleum products

The following items will NOT be accepted:

- Hazardous waste, including:
 - Paint
 - Herbicides
 - Fertilizers
 - Non-rechargeable batteries

**Freezers, Refrigerators, and AC units will be accepted from
April 7-April 11 at Country Comfort located at 122 E. Thomas.**

Payne County Bank will offer free document shredding from 8:30am-10:30am.
